







There is clearly a leat system here. There is no mention of a mill on the tithe map. The only other explanation is a system for water meadows. However the position of the buildings would suggest a mill.



1888 OS map


Clearly there is a manmade set of channels in this location which would suggest that there may have been a mill here at some time. By this time it is less complex than on the tithe map.



86 showing on the tithe map as Seaborough Meadow and its use a meadow (6 acres).

89 showing on the tithe map as Little Windsor Meadow and its use a meadow (13 acres)

Both are shown between two streams so were either the remnants of a mill leat with meadows, possibly water meadows, or originally water meadows.



Clearly there is some control of the water system here with three sluices shown. It may have been the site of Heifer Mill and is shown in Heifer Mill under Mosterton.
