

Randall Family – Mill Labourers in the Loudwater Mills, near High Wycombe c1891

Hello Elizabeth

Sorry it has taken a while to reply.

Here is a summary of the Randall family, I kept it brief but might be able to give more.

The parents were Francis Randall (1840-1875) and a jobbing gardener and Eliza (Elizabeth) Cooper with 8 children - 4 daughters and 4 sons

3 sons worked at a mill were George, Alfred and Walter.

According to 1891 census. Living in Loudwater with Mother Eliza

Frank Randall age 25 (1866 in Esher Surrey) a mill labourer. Frank died about 1932 in Wandsworth.

Walter Randall age 23 (1869 Penn) a mill labourer. Walter moved and married in Marylebone. London.

George Randall age 20 (1870 Penn) a mill labourer. George moved and married in Brentford. London.

Also on 1891 census it shows a mill - its looks like Salhouse Paga Mill [misspelling].

I will presume that Paga is Paper. it would be interesting to know if this mill did exist.

I hope to access some old maps at some time. I have one old map that shows mills but not the names.
