
In connection with Mildred's article about Empire Mills, here is a picture of Phoenix Roller Mills in Grahamstown, Eastern Cape:















This drawing shows Roller Mills by Simon, Turner and Robinson, the scourer is American!




Some of the elevators were 9m tall!
